## Mission of the translator

- Ability to work under pressure;
- Ability to prepare reports or develop small projects.

## **JOB REQUIREMENTS**

- Regular travel to businesses and public institutions
- Proficiency in at least one of the other languages (English if native French speaker, and French if native English speaker)
- Possibility of travel to headquarters (Dschang) for skills development seminars.
